In the PS I Love You mini-documentary, *Clothed in Grace: From Hand-me-downs to Helping Hands*, the Kirby's emotional journey unfolds as a powerful arc of transformation. When they first opened their home to foster children, they were overwhelmed — juggling diapers, thrift store clothes, and the ache of watching little ones arrive with nothing but a grocery bag of ill-fitting clothes. Yet, through each challenge, their hearts softened into thankfulness as they witnessed God's faithfulness in providing every need and surrounding them with support. That thankfulness grew into a calling — a deep desire to ensure no child would ever feel unseen or unprepared.
