

Pack A Care Bag

Option 1: In a large group setting, use the attached guide to purchase items for a care bag. You can hide individual items under chairs before children come in the room and then allow children to come on stage and put their item into a backpack, while discussing why that item is a need for children in foster care.

Option 2: For younger children in a small group setting, print a copy of p. 2 for each child. Allow children to color, then cut and paste the items onto the bookbag as you discuss items that children in foster care need.

Option 3: For older children in a small group setting, print a copy of p. 3 for each child. Allow children to draw items (or cut up magazine pictures) that children will need in a care bag.

AGE 0-1 YEARS OLD - SPECIFY BOY OR GIRL

- Diaper bag
- Baby blanket (boy, girl, neutral)
- Diapers size newborn, 1, 2, 3, 4 or 5
- Baby wipes
- Bibs
- Teething toy
- Baby wash/shampoo
- Diaper rash ointment
- Baby toy (either hand held or small floor toy, stuffed lovey)
- Bible story book/Beginner Bible for Toddlers
- Baby grooming kit, brush

AGE 2-5 YEARS OLD - SPECIFY BOY OR GIRL


- Character backpack
- Blanket
- Sippy cup
- Toothbrush/toothpaste
- 3 in 1 (soap, shampoo and conditioner) for kids
- Kids Bible (Beginners Bible or kid friendly Bible)
- Stuffed animal
- Small toy (ex: games, Barbie, car, truck, baby doll, etc.)
- Hair brush or comb or hair accessories for girls

AGE 6-9 OR AGE 10-12 YEARS OLD - SPECIFY BOY OR GIRL

- Duffle bag/School backpack
- Blanket
- Refillable water bottle
- Toothbrush/toothpaste
- Soap, shampoo and conditioner, deodorant
- Detangling brushes
- Bible for kids
- Small Toy (ex: Barbie, legos, cards, games, football, books, jewelry, etc)
- Stuffed Animal (age appropriate)
- School Supplies
