

Pictionary/Charades

Preview all cards to make sure they fit the age and context of the group you are working with!

Option 1: In large or small group settings, lead the children in a game of Pictionary (or Charades) with the following word cards. Simply print p. 2 - 5, cut them apart, mix them up, and place them in a bowl.

Option 2: Use the emotion words on p. 2 to discuss the emotions of children in foster care. Direct the children to sit in a circle. You can play "Reverse Charades" by having one child turn around and close their eyes. Show the emotion card to all the other children and have them make their best faces showing the emotion. The one child turns around to guess the emotion.

Option 3: Use the professional titles on p. 3 and 4 to discuss the adult helpers who serve children in foster care. Lay the cards out on a counter or tape them to a wall. Describe the person or profession, and allow children to race to pick up the card of the person they think you are describing. Take time to pray for each of these professions.


